Better Homes and Gardens Complete Guide to Quilting *

We will be making the Color Forms quilt on page 18. Choose the size you want to make. That will determine the amount of fabric you'll need. We will add a flange accent not in the original design. Don't forget to look inside the back cover for another version of this quilt.

Fabrics* Assorted fabrics for background and appliqués.
You want some contrast between your background and appliqué fabrics.
1/3 yd. for flange accent

Batting*

Stabilizers Steam a Seam 2*

Totally Stable*

Non-fusible interfacing*

Threads

Mettler 50 wt. for piecing*

Embroidery thread* to contrast or match appliqué pieces

YLI invisible thread*

Quilting thread*

YLI bobbin thread*

Basic supplies

Rotary cutter, mat and acrylic ruler.*

Tape measure *

Seam ripper and scissors*

Chalk to mark quilting lines*

Masking tape

Basting pins*

Scissors for cutting paper*

Notebook and pen

Fine-line sharpie

Open-toe embroidery foot

¼ inch foot

80/12 needle for piecing*

Sewing machine* in good working order and can do a zigzag, bring your
knee lift if you have one.

If you'd like to try hand appliqué

Appliqué pins*

Thimble*

Straw needles*, size 10 or 11

Small sharp scissors* to cut appliqué pieces

Embroidery* or silk thread
