Machine in good working order*
Machine needles*
¼ inch foot
Thread for piecing*
Scissors* to cut fabric and to cut plastic templates
Template plastic*
Sharpie pen-fine point
Lead pencil and or/chalk*
Rotary cutter and mat*
Ruler*
Walking foot and/or free-motion foot
Machine quilting thread*
Notebook and pen

If you'd like to try hand-quilting

Quilting hoop*
Between needles, size 10*
Hand-quilting thread*
Quilting template*
Marking tool*
Small scissors*
Thimble*

Fabric*

Blocks: 1/2 yard each of nine different fabrics. Be sure to get a mix of patterns and dark, medium and light. You can certainly use more than nine if you'd like.

Sashing: 1 ½ yards

Posts: (small setting squares) ½ yard

Border: 2 ¼ yards

Backing: Depending on size quilt you choose to make, approx. 6 yards.

Binding: ¾ yard
