

EMBROIDERY CLUB SUPPLY LIST

Items indicated with an asterisk* are available for purchase at Country Stitches

Embroidery machine with:

- Power cord
- Thread stand
- Embroidery bobbin case (if you use a different one for the embroidery process)
- Embroidery hoops – large oval for Bernina machines
- 505 spray*
- 75/11 Sharp embroidery needles
- Bobbin fill*
- Thread snips*
- Paper scissors
- Fabric marking device, **chalk** or water soluble
- Straight pins

½ yard of two complimentary shades of Dupioni silk, if you can find the shaded silk (warp and weft fibers are two different colors) the look is very lustrous.

Quilt Fuse fusible batting, ½ yard- **this is going to be available at the shop late in the week of 3/17-25.**

6 shades of embroidery thread, 3 for each color of silk – I chose to feature the opposing fabric by using its coloring for the main thread color on the other fabric and vice a versa for the other piece.

Sticky stabilizer – a sticky back tearaway stabilizer...enough for 6 hoopings with your large hoop

60” of fringe type trim for your pillow

Sewing thread to match the dominant color of silk

Walking foot

Slide on tray table for sewing

Sewing bobbin case

Teflon iron shield

14” pillow insert

Aqua mesh water soluble stabilizer

Empty bobbin

Rotary cutter and ruler

Rotary cutting mat

Prior to class please cut two 8” squares from each of your silk fabrics and seam two opposing colors together with a ¼” seam, press the seam open and then join the two sides together, with opposing fabrics side by side, with a ¼” seam, press the seam open. Fuse this square to a square of Quilt Fuse batting. Spray with starch and press thoroughly **three times.**

Cut two rectangles of your dominant silk fabric into 12” x 16” rectangles and cut two rectangles of Quilt Fuse batting that measure 11” x 16”, bring to class
