

Weekender Duffle Bag Supply List

Items with an asterisk are available at Jamie's Country Stitches

Totes with Zippers Book by Cindy Taylor Oates

Sewing machine (power cord, slide on tray table)

6" x 24" ruler*

Rotary cutter*

Cutting mat*

Machine needles- 80/12 jeans*

Shears for cutting fabric

Scissors for snipping threads

Chalk marker*

Straight stitch foot (Bernina #37)*

Walking foot (Bernina #50)*

Peltex (non-fusible type)- one 10 ½" x 19 ½" and one 9 ½" x 18 ½"

Heat n bond lite- one 10 ½" x 19 ½" and one 9 ½" x 18 ½"

22" separating zipper, **I have black for sale for \$1.00**

Binding strip- 2 ¼" x 60" in a complimentary color to your outer fabric and bag bottom fabric

Thread to match your webbing, bag bottom, outer and lining fabrics*

Webbing- 1" x 122"

4- 3/8" purse feet

Long, strong straight pins

Fabric:

Outer Fabric – 2 yard

Lining Fabric – 1 ¼ yard

Pellon Thermolan fleece - 22" x 44" and 13"x 44"

Preparation: Cut a 22" x 44" rectangle of each of the above fabrics and make a quilt sandwich with the fleece in between and quilt the fabric. Cut a 13" x 44" rectangle of each fabric and make a quilt sandwich with the fleece and quilt the fabric.

Cut 18" x 24" and 11 ½" x 21 ½" rectangles from the outer fabric and bring it to class.

Please bring any leftover fabric to class.
